Study Abroad Community Design Installations, Riva San Vitale, Switzerland // Study Abroad
Development and implementation of an experiential, community-engaged practice-based curriculum during the spring 2019 Riva San Vitale European Study Abroad Program. Students worked collaboratively to investigate the nature of professional practice by designing, fabricating, and installing temporary community exhibits in downtown Riva San Vitale. The program was supplemented by a week-long workshop led by skilled practitioners from the award-winning creative practice, Aberrant Architecture, who lived in residence with the students during the final week of their construction efforts.

Spatial Practice Lab, Undergraduate, Bachelor of Architecture // Master of Architecture
Working with leaders in the City of Roanoke and members of the Melrose-Orange neighborhood, I implemented an experiential, community-engaged practice-based curriculum in professional practice. Through a mixture of lecture-based content and experiential, practice-based learning, students learn about and interrogate the nature of architectural practice while providing conceptual design services to underserved communities in Roanoke. The spring of 2018 saw student teams working on streetscape and neighborhood enhancement projects while teams in the fall of 2018 worked to develop housing prototypes as part of a neighborhood visioning process. Students managed the projects, tracked expenses and time, and presented their work in a variety of community venues.

Integrative Design Laboratory, Bachelor of Architecture, coordinator since Summer 2016
Lead for development and roll-out of the new 4th-year Integrative Design Lab curriculum in the School of Architecture + Design. This involves facilitated resource-sharing, establishment of outcomes and metrics, administration of a student design competition each semester, as well as overall coordination between three studio locations.
